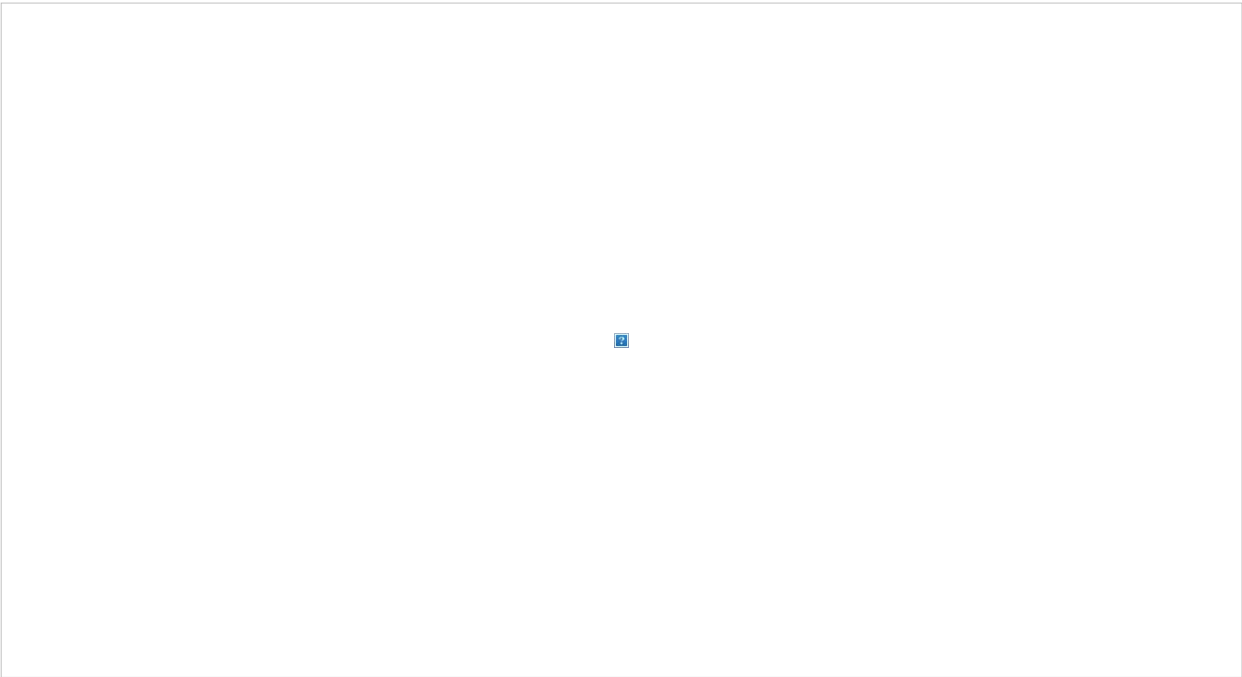

I received the same emails. I wonder if others received them as well.

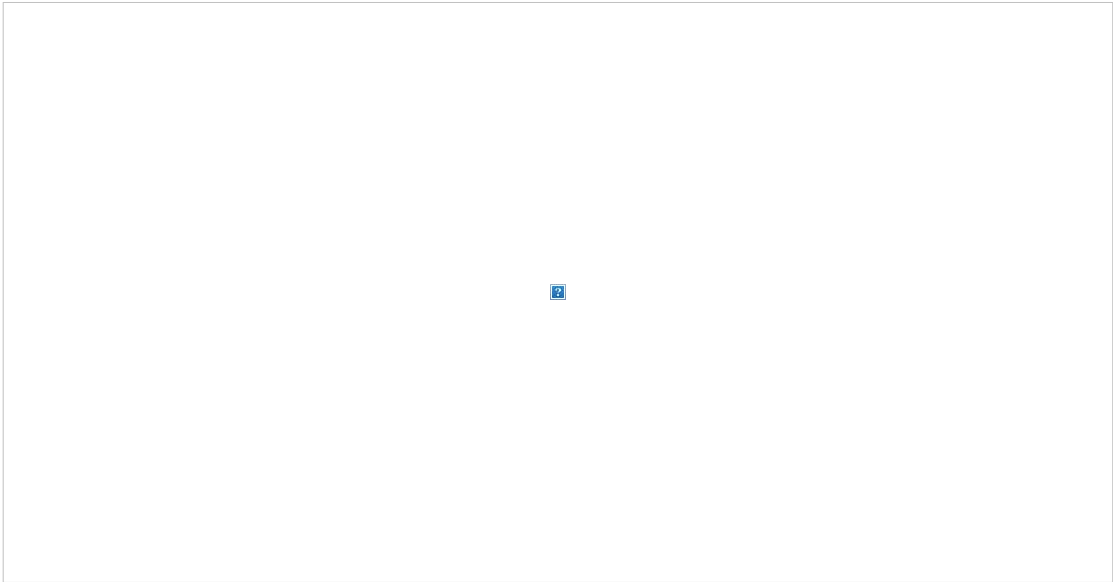
