White listing information for Mailchimp delivery servers

If you're having trouble sending emails to a group of people at a company, it's probably because of their email firewall. It tends to look suspicious when multiple people at one company are getting the same email at the same time. You might send this page to their IT group and politely ask them to use the information here to whitelist our servers. This will hopefully prevent future delivery problems.
